

Hazard Identification & Risk Assessment Workshop

Over the past 12 years there has been an effort internationally and specifically at the CSA Playground level to introduce the process of Hazard Identification and Risk Assessment where there are play components, structures or designs that are not covered by the prescriptive requirements of the existing Standards. ASTM F1487 1.6.1 already allows for the designers to perform a risk assessment where this occurs.

The workshop will discuss the principles of risk assessment in general and specifically as it relates to playgrounds, and play environments. Participants are invited to submit detailed case studies for review in the workshop. There will be a total of three scenarios investigated.
